The election for members of the Camden City School District Advisory Board of Education will be held on Tuesday, **November 3, 2020**.

The deadline for filing to seek a seat on the nine-member board is **July 28, 2020** at 4 p.m.

Nominating petitions are available from the Office of the County Clerk – Elections Division between 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. The County Clerk is located at 520 Market Street, Room 102, Camden, New Jersey 08102. The contact number is (856) 225-5300.

There are **three (3)** seats available which will be voted upon, each for a term of three (3) years.

Candidates filing a nominating petition for board membership must meet the following qualifications:

- He/she is a citizen of the United States of America.
- He/she must be at least 18 (eighteen) years of age to qualify for office.
- He/she must be able to read and write.
- He/she has been a resident of the municipality from which he/she is to be elected for at least one (1) year preceding the date of election.
- He/she is not disqualified as a voter pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:4-1.
- He/she is a registered voter in the district.
- Not hold office as a mayor or member of the governing body of the same district.
- He/she is not disqualified from membership on the Board due to conviction of a crime of offense listed in N.J.S.A. 18A:12-1.
- He/she has no interest in any contract with, or claim against the Board.
